

# Notice of Primary Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 2024 at the polling places in Butler County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election as the number of candidates filing for office did not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and will advance to the November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 General Election, when candidates for township officers, village board members, public power district boards (grossing under \$40 million), and educational service unit board members also may be elected.

#### City of David City Sales and Use Tax

"Shall the governing body of the City of David City, Nebraska continue to impose a sales and use tax of ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.50%) upon the same transactions within the City of David City on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, for a ten (10) year period commencing on October 1, 2024 and ending October 1, 2034 with the proceeds collected to be used for water treatment works and systems, water distribution facilities, and water resources projects, including, but not limited to, pumping stations, transmission lines, and mains and their appurtenances within the City of David City, Nebraska?"

If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such tax, then the governing body of the City of David City shall be empowered as provided by Section 77-27,142 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and shall forthwith proceed to impose a tax pursuant to the Nebraska Revenue Act. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the governing body of the City of David City shall not impose such tax.

**School Bond Election  
Platte County School District 0001  
(Columbus Public Schools)  
In the State of Nebraska**

"Shall Platte County School District 0001 (Columbus Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska (the "District") issue general obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Twenty-six Million Dollars (\$26,000,000), for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of additions, renovations and improvements to the District's existing buildings and facilities, which may include (1) safety and security improvements in the District's existing buildings to include installation of bullet resistant window coverings, cameras, and secure and controlled entrances, (2) additions and improvements to existing elementary buildings to include dining areas and kitchens at Centennial, Emerson, North Park and West Park elementary schools, (3) addition and improvements to the existing middle school building to include a classroom addition and remodeling of dining facilities, and (4) providing for the necessary furniture, equipment and apparatus for such additions, renovations and improvements; such bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

**NONPARTISAN AUTO ADVANCE** - IF THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES PROPERLY FILED FOR NOMINATION AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION FOR DIRECTORS OF NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICTS, MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE AREAS, MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF CLASS III SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND OFFICERS OF CLASS II CITIES DO NOT EXCEED TWO CANDIDATES FOR EACH POSITION TO BE FILLED, ANY SUCH CANDIDATES SHALL BE DECLARED NOMINATED AND THEIR NAMES SHALL NOT APPEAR ON THE PRIMARY BALLOT.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment, title, and text to be published by the Office of the Secretary of State, once a week for 3 weeks prior to the Primary Election.
